## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill would require the Department, beginning in calendar 2008, to annually determine for each BadgerCare recipient who has access to employer sponsored health insurance for which the employer pays less than 80% of the costs, the actual percentage of the insurance plan costs paid. An annual report to the Legislature would be required on these determinations.

The Department does not currently collect this information. However, the Department, is planning to develop a database of employer health insurance for BadgerCare recipients. The Department has recently issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for building this database. This database is intended to streamline insurance verification for BadgerCare recipients, but will also have the data to produce the determinations and report required under this bill. Once this database is developed, the costs will be minimal to meet the requirements of this bill.

If something developed that prevented completion of the insurance database, or if its development was delayed, then there would be a significant cost to produce the report under this bill. If the insurance database was not available, DHFS would have to modify its current system and would have to obtain the information from the employers. It will also be a burden on employers, because DHFS would have to collect more specific information from them. A preliminary estimate of this cost is \$300,000 GPR on a one-time basis.
