**NOTE:** Under current all-terrain vehicle (ATV) statutes, the department of natural resources (DNR) is directed to encourage and supervise a system of ATV routes and trails. To fulfill this charge, the statutes permit the DNR to establish standards and procedures for certifying the designation (i.e., approval to receive state funds) of ATV routes and trails.

The DNR has issued current standards and procedures for ATV use on department lands as guidance documents. This bill draft requires DNR to promulgate administrative rules to establish standards and procedures for certifying the designation of ATV routes and trails under the control of the department. By requiring the standards and procedures to be promulgated as rules, this draft will require public hearings on the current policies, and any changes to those policies, through the agency process for developing rules and the legislative administrative rule review process. Under this draft, the department must consider the

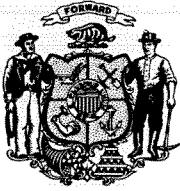
