Hi Beth, Sorry for the delay in getting aback to you.

Comments follow:

-line 9 of page two of the bill - we need to add "Northern Highland-" in front of American Legion State Forest. One of the locations is in Vilas Co and that part is in Northern Highland; our forestry people have joined up the two project names for years anyway.

Regarding the Drafter's Note: I think the bill language is fine, other than the addition above. Mary questions a number of things which I will address in the order she cites her concerns:

1. Problems with the legal descriptions - actually., I don't see any problems -

a. we intend this to be the western most 60 acres in the description in the bill. (she could drop the "ern" from western.) The intended parcel would measure about 2,640 feet north to south and 990 feet east to west. The SW corner of the land to be leased would be the same as the SW corner of Section 13.

b. The S1/4 is just that - the southerly tier of 40 acre parcels across Section 36. the land intended for lease would span parts of the SESW and the SWSE. If we have this general legal description for the legislation we have a little flexibility. If and when ever leased, we'll require the lessee to survey the lease area to pin it down.

c.Yes. any 30 acres within the S1/4 west of STH 47. in reality though, primarily parts of SESW and SWSE 2. Yes, WIS 47 equals STH 47
