

**SENATE AMENDMENT 2,
TO 2007 SENATE BILL 232**

March 11, 2008 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH, HUMAN SERVICES, INSURANCE,
AND JOB CREATION.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 12: delete that line and substitute:

3 “450.09 **(2m)** PATIENTS’ RIGHTS. (a) Except as provided in par. (b), every
4 pharmacist has a duty to promptly”.

5 **2.** Page 3, line 15: after that line insert:

6 “(b) A pharmacist may decline to dispense a contraceptive for a patient if either
7 of the following applies and the pharmacist ensures that the patient will have access
8 to the contraceptive elsewhere:

9 1. The pharmacist objects to dispensing the contraceptive on moral or religious
10 grounds.

11 2. The pharmacist is employed at a pharmacy that is operated or controlled by
12 an organization that objects to contraception on moral or religious grounds.”.
