- **1.** Page 3, line 12: delete that line and substitute:
- 3 "450.09 **(2m)** Patients' rights. (a) Except as provided in par. (b), every pharmacist has a duty to promptly".
 - **2.** Page 3, line 15: after that line insert:
 - "(b) A pharmacist may decline to dispense a contraceptive for a patient if either of the following applies and the pharmacist ensures that the patient will have access to the contraceptive elsewhere:
 - The pharmacist objects to dispensing the contraceptive on moral or religious grounds.
- 2. The pharmacist is employed at a pharmacy that is operated or controlled by an organization that objects to contraception on moral or religious grounds.".
