1 AN ACT *to amend* 942.08 (2) (d) (intro.) of the statutes; **relating to:** invasion of 2 privacy.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, no one may enter another person's private property without that person's consent and look into that person's dwelling unit for the purpose of sexual gratification. This bill prohibits any person from looking into another person's dwelling unit from a common area in a multidwelling building.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
