1 AN ACT to amend 942.08 (2) (d) (intro.) of the statutes; relating to: invasion of privacy.


Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, no one may enter another person's private property without that person's consent and look into that person's dwelling unit for the purpose of sexual gratification. This bill prohibits any person from looking into another person's dwelling unit from a common area in a multidwelling building.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:


- SECTION 1. 942.08 (2) (d) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 942.08 (2) (d) (intro.) Enters another person's private property without that

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, line 3: before that line insert:

"Section 1d. 942.08 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

942.08 (1) (b) "Private place" means a place where a person may reasonably expect to be safe from being observed without his or her knowledge and consent and includes a locker room or a dressing room.

SECTION 1h. 942.08 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

942.08 (2) (b) For the purpose of sexual arousal or gratification and without the consent of each person who is present in the private place, looks into a private place that is in a school building or on any school grounds or that is, or is part of, a public accommodation, as defined in s. 134.48 (1) (b), and in which a person may reasonably be expected to be nude or partially nude.
