Hi Becky,

We want to include, in the required disclosure of any vaccines/medication/treatments the puppy has received, a disclosure of if the puppy has or has not been seen by a licensed Wisconsin veterinarian. If the puppy has been seen, we would like those medical records to be available to the potential purchaser prior to purchase of the animal--from our understanding, under current law they don't gain access to those records until after they become the owner of the animal, but we want them to have access to them before sale. We would also like to require the seller to give the purchaser the name and contact information of the veterinarian who examined the dog. If the puppy has not been seen, it must be explicitly disclosed to the purchaser that it has not been seen by a vet.
