## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill would require a cellular telephone service provider to refund to a customer or credit to the customer's account any amount charged to the customer in excess of the amount actually owed by the customer.

As the department already enforces provisions of ATCP 123 regulating telecommunications, we do not anticipate an increase in workload. This bill simply provides the department with another enforcement tool to assist consumers with cellular telephone billing complaints.
