Anyway, I was approached by my Brigade Commander about National Guard Plates. He asked me to research how we could get the 32nd Brigade "Red Arrow" placed on either the Veteran Plates or the National Guard Plate. I researched this through my sources here at DMV and was told that it would need to go through the Legislature. I know all of the symbols are stickers now, so I'm thinking this should be kind of easy to make an adjustment to statute to include the Red Arrow or the 57th Brigade symbol to either plate type. This is where I need your assistance. Can you help me make this a reality? Thank You.

1 AN ACT ...; relating to: special distinguishing registration plates for certain
2 vehicles owned by members of the national guard.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, state residents who are members or retired members of the national guard may obtain, for automobiles and certain other vehicles that they own or lease, special distinguishing registration plates that display the words "Wisconsin guard member" (national guard special plates).

Under this bill, if an applicant for initial issuance of national guard special plates identifies himself or herself as a member or former member of the 32nd Brigade or the 57th Brigade, the Department of Transportation (DOT) must affix to one of these special plates a registration decal or tag (sticker) that includes a symbol associated with the brigade of which the applicant is or was a member. An applicant for renewal of registration of national guard special plates may also receive this registration sticker, free of charge, if the sticker was not previously affixed by DOT to either of the applicant's national guard special plates.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 **SECTION 1.** 341.08 (2) (f) of the statutes is created to read:

2 341.08 (2) (f) If the application is for registration of a vehicle under s. 341.14
3 (6m), an opportunity for the applicant to identify himself or herself as a member or
4 former member of the 32nd Brigade or 57th Brigade.

5 **SECTION 2.** 341.14 (6m) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

6 341.14 (6m) (d) 1. If an applicant for initial issuance of special plates under this
7 subsection identifies himself or herself in the application as a member or former
8 member of the 32nd Brigade or 57th Brigade, the department shall affix to one of the
9 plates issued under this subsection a registration decal or tag that includes a symbol
10 associated with the brigade of which the applicant is or was a member.

11 2. Upon receiving any application for renewal of registration of a vehicle for
12 which special plates have been issued under this subsection, if the applicant
13 identifies himself or herself in the application as a member or former member of the
14 32nd Brigade or 57th Brigade and if the department has not previously issued a plate
15 with a decal or tag affixed as provided under subd. 1. or 3., the department shall
16 provide a registration decal or tag described in subd. 1. to the applicant, free of
17 charge, with instructions for placement of the decal or tag on one of the special plates.

18 3. Notwithstanding subd. 2., upon receiving any application for renewal of
19 registration of a vehicle for which special plates have been issued under this
20 subsection, if the applicant identifies himself or herself in the application as a
21 member or former member of the 32nd Brigade or 57th Brigade and if the
22 department is required under s. 341.135 (2) to issue new registration plates for the
23 vehicle, the department shall affix to one of the plates a registration decal or tag

1 AN ACT *to create* 341.08 (2) (f) and 341.14 (6m) (d) of the statutes; **relating to:**
2 special distinguishing registration plates for certain vehicles owned by
3 members of the national guard.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, state residents who are members or retired members of the national guard may obtain, for automobiles and certain other vehicles that they own or lease, special distinguishing registration plates that display the words "Wisconsin guard member" (national guard special plates).

Under this bill, if an applicant for initial issuance of national guard special plates identifies himself or herself as a member or former member of the 32nd ~~Brigade or the 57th Brigade~~, the Department of Transportation (DOT) must affix to one of these special plates a ~~registration decal or tag~~ (sticker) that includes a symbol associated with the ~~brigade~~ of which the applicant is or was a member. An applicant for renewal of registration of national guard special plates may also receive this ~~registration~~ sticker, free of charge, if the sticker was not previously affixed by DOT to either of the applicant's national guard special plates.

For further information see the **state** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

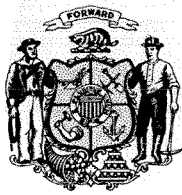
