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



Hi, John. As you'd asked, this note lays out the 2 issues that we ask your consideration of, in SB 340.

1. The bill would result in a 1-time cost to DMV of \$15,800 that DMV cannot absorb within our current budget, as you can see in the fiscal estimate. We'd like to ask if you'd consider an amendment to appropriate a 1-time appropriation to DMV's appropriation 20.395(5)(cq) of \$15,800. Several of our bills in the past few years have included this appropriation; and the drafting attorney is aware of how to write the language to make it clear that it's 1-time only, and not ongoing.

2. The bill on page 2 line 11 and page 3, line 2, and also on page 2, line 18, directs DOT to "affix to one of the plates" the decal that we'd issue for one of the 5 enumerated units. This would be for plates that either are issued the first time or are re-issued (new metal) at renewal time. However, DMV's plate issuance process is completely automated, and for us to "affix" decals to the plates we would need to pull those plates out of the process, open the plate envelope and affix the decal, put the plates back into the envelope and address the mailing label -- all manually.

What we actually do is send the plates, and the decal, to the registrant, with instructions on how the registrant should affix the decal. This is shown correctly in the bill on page 2, line 19-20.

We ask if you would consider an amendment to eliminate the language that requires us to affix the decal, and instead use the same language that the bill uses on page 2, line 19-20, for the situations of new issue and re-issue. Again, the drafting attorney could easily craft the amendment language; Rep Musser introduced similar language to amend his AB 538 Red Arrow Brigade plate, to correct the "affix" language.

Thanks very much for your consideration.
