## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

OCI is unable to determine the state fiscal effect of this bill. Additional resources may be needed to monitor compliance. Additional responsibilities in the performance of insurer examinations combined with increased complaint activity against insurers could result in an increase in the need for resources beyond the agency's existing budget authority. OCI anticipates that once the agency gains experience with compliance issues related to SB-348 an assessment of agency needs related to this bill will yield a reliable estimate.

OCI is unable to determine the state and local fiscal effect. OCI does not collect information related to local government auto premium rate payments that would enable an accurate fiscal determination.
