## **2007 SENATE BILL 359**

December 17, 2007 – Introduced by Senators Risser, Lassa and Taylor, cosponsored by Representatives Albers, Gronemus, Kessler, Hahn, A. Williams, Petrowski, Berceau and Jeskewitz. Referred to Committee on Ethics Reform and Government Operations.

- 1 AN ACT to amend 11.34 (1); and to create 11.34 (1m) of the statutes; relating
- 2 **to:** religious or charitable gifts from candidates.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, no person may demand, solicit, take, invite, or receive from a candidate any gift of anything of value for a religious or charitable cause. No candidate may make, intimate, or promise such a gift.

This bill permits a person to take or receive a gift of anything of value from a candidate for a religious or charitable organization. The bill also permits a candidate to make, intimate, or promise such a gift.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 11.34 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

11.34 **(1)** No person may demand, solicit, take, invite or receive from a candidate any gift of anything of value for a religious, charitable or fraternal cause or for any organization other than a political committee or group, except that a person may take or receive from a candidate a gift of anything of value for a religious

1	or charitable organization. No candidate may make, intimate or promise such a gift
2	that is prohibited under this subsection.

4	11.34 (1m) No person may demand, solicit, or invite from a candidate any gift
