**SUBJECT:** TECHNICAL MEMO TO FISCAL ESTIMATE FOR 2007 SB 379

2007 SB 379 requires that cigarette manufacturers file a written certification with Commerce stating that the cigarettes it seeks to sell in Wisconsin meet fire safety standards. Section 167.35 (2) (f), Stats., of the bill requires that a manufacturer pay a fee of \$250 for each type of cigarette listed in each certification which the manufacturer files with the Department. However, 2007 SB 379 does not contain provisions for the deposit/credit of the resulting revenue.

The Department recommends that sentence two ("All moneys received...shall be credited to this appropriation") of Section 1 of 2007 SB 379 be amended to include s. 167.35, Stats.
