- "(1) EXEMPTIONS FROM CERTAIN LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS.
- (a) Persons certified by the dietitians affiliated credentialing board as a dietitian on the effective date of this act. Notwithstanding section 448.78 (3) to (5) of the statutes, as affected by this act, no later than the first day of the 7th month beginning after the effective date of this paragraph, the dietetics and nutrition care services affiliated credentialing board shall grant a license under section 448.78 of the statutes to a person who, on the the effective date of this act, held a valid certificate as a dietitian granted by the dietitians affiliated credentialing board.
- (b) Persons registered as a registered dietitian with the American Dietetic Association on the effective date of this act. Notwithstanding section 448.78 (3) to (5) of the statutes, as affected by this act, the dietetics and nutrition care services

The Dietitians Affiliated Credentialing Board contacted Jason Johns yesterday about a concern they had with the grandfather language on P18 Section 62 of our bill. As it was written it would have made it hard for them to implement the bill and also for people to become grandfathered. It also would have created a loophole for people who are not currently certified at effective date of bill to become certified in the 13 month window and become licensed in the grandfathering clause. This is not our intent. After discussing with them, this is language we have come up with. Would you please pass on to the drafter to have it corrected in the bill? I know you have submitted for introduction all ready, but as mentioned they just contacted Jason yesterday, January 17th. Could this language be changed in the bill with a simple amendment and then just changed in the actual draft for the Assembly companion as it has not been introduced yet? The language and the reasons for changing are detailed in the attached Word document. Thank you and let me know if you have any questions or need further

REVISION NEEDED TO P 18, Section 62 of LRB-1288/5:

The current language in Section 62 should be replaced with the following:

(1) EXEMPTION FROM CERTAIN LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS. Notwithstanding section 448.78 (3) to (5) of the statutes, as affected by this act, no later than the first day of the 13th month beginning after the effective date of this act, the dietetics and nutrition care services affiliated credentialing board shall grant a license under section 448.78 of the statutes to a person who is currently certified by the dietitians affiliated credentialing board on the effective date of this act. Persons who no later than the first day of the 13 month beginning after the effective date of this act provide sufficient evidence to the dietetics and nutrition care services affiliated credentialing board that they were registered as a registered dietitian with the commission on dietetic registration of the American Dietetic Association on the effective date of this act shall be granted a license under section 448.78 of the statutes by the dietetics and nutrition care services affiliated credentialing board.
