Stuart and Matt --

The person who answered my email says "this does not create a new exemption". I disagree. The purpose of the proposed language is to say that a person who provides the services outlined in the term, "medical nutrition therapy", does not need a license to practice medicine and surgery as that term is defined under s. 448.01 (9). Under current law, a person who wishes to practice any part of the activities described in the definition medicine and surgery needs a license to

practice medicine and surgery. Therefore, the proposed language exempts dieticians or nutritionists who provide medical nutrition therapy from the requirement to obtain a license to practice medicine and surgery. This is not a problem in and of itself; however, the proposed language does not belong in the definition of medical nutrition therapy.

This is not an uncommon issue in the regulation chapters; we deal with these regulatory boundaries in the manner I proposed.

I believe the constituent is confused by what I am proposing. I believe I can address the constituent's concern with the approach I suggested, and it is an approach used for midwives, nurses, dentists, chiropractors, dental hygienists, optometrists, acupuncturists, etc. Here is a more thorough explanation of what the amendment would do:

The amendment I propose does not exempt persons who are offering "medical nutrition therapy" services from the requirement to obtain a license to practice dietetics or nutrition care services if the person is seeking to practice dietetics or nutrition care services; because "medical nutrition therapy" is included in the definition of "dietetics and nutrition care services", a person MUST be licensed as a dietitian or nutritionist to offer medical nutrition therapy.

Nor does the amendment I am proposing exempt persons from the requirement to obtain a license to practice medicine and surgery under subchapter II of ch. 448 if that person is seeking to practice medicine and surgery.

The amendment I propose exempts persons from the requirement to obtain a license to practice medicine and surgery IF AND ONLY IF the person is:

- 1. licensed to practice dietetics and nutrition care services
- 2. practicing dietetics and nutrition care services (which services include medical nutrition therapy).

Please let me know how you would like me to proceed.

Hi Tracy:

Here is the response to your suggestion. Let me know what you think.:

No. Not good. We are not seeking an exemption for these folks to be able to practice medicine and surgery under 448. Drafter is way misunderstanding the issue.

The issue is that the Med Society just wanted a misnomer on the term "medical". We do not want to remove the term as it is vital to "medical nutrition therapy" term. They just want this clarified that it does not constitute practice of medicine so that no others are confused by this. It is not a "substantive exemption". It is to clarify the term. I think it fits fine immediately following definition of medical nutrition therapy at 448.70 (5) which it is meant to clarify. However if she wishes to place somewhere else in bill and refer to 448.70(5) then this would probably do as well. But prefer it there if possible, and this does not create a new exemption nor does it say that those practicing medical nutrition therapy do not need a dietitian license or medical license. They will still need a license under this bill, but do not practice medicine. Does this make sense?

Hi Stuart and Matt -

The person making the request to amend the bill has asked for the new language to go in the definition of "medical nutrition therapy", but the proposed amendment language is a substantive exemption from the practice of medicine and surgery. So, I don't think p. 8, line 4 is where the proposed amendment language should be placed.

Instead, I am going to insert, on page 6 after line 13, an amendment to s. 448.03 (2) (a) which will exempt persons who are licensed and practicing dietetics and nutrition care services from the requirement to obtain a license under Subchapter II of ch. 448 (which requires persons to obtain a license to practice medicine and surgery).


