
The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 100.287 of the statutes is created to read:

100.287 Provision of bags by retailers. No person who is engaged in the retail sale of goods intended for personal, household, or family use may provide a bag to a customer for the purpose of carrying the customer's purchases unless the bag is any of the following:

(1) A compostable plastic bag, as defined by the department by rule.

This bill prohibits a person who is engaged in the retail sale of goods for personal, family, or household use from providing a plastic bag for a customer's purchases unless the bag is compostable or reusable.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 100.287 of the statutes is created to read:

100.287 Provision of bags by retailers. No person who is engaged in the retail sale of goods intended for personal, household, or family use may provide a plastic bag to a customer for the purpose of carrying the customer's purchases unless the plastic bag is any of the following:

- (2) Intended for reuse, if the bag is made of plastic that is not less than 2.25
 thousandths of an inch in thickness.
