2007 SENATE BILL 457

February 5, 2008 – Introduced by Senators Vinehout, Hansen, Lassa and Kapanke, cosponsored by Representatives Musser, Nerison, Hubler, Shilling, Boyle, Albers, Berceau, Townsend and A. Ott. Referred to Committee on Public Health, Senior Issues, Long Term Care and Privacy.

AN ACT to create 40.21 (1r) of the statutes; relating to: coverage of long-term

care districts under the Wisconsin Retirement System.

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Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides that, if the governing body of a long-term care district adopts a resolution to elect to become a participating employer in the Wisconsin Retirement System (WRS) before May 15 of any year and official notice of that election is received by the Department of Employee Trust Funds (DETF) on or before May 15, the effective date of the participation of the long-term care district is the ensuing July 1. This differs from current law, which provides that, if an employer adopts a resolution to elect to become a participating employer in the WRS before November 15 of any year and official notice of that election is received by DETF on or before November 15, the effective date of the participation of the long-term care district is the ensuing January 1.

Because this bill relates to public employee retirement or pensions, it may be referred to the Joint Survey Committee on Retirement Systems for a report to be printed as an appendix to the bill.

SENATE BILL 457

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SECTION 1

40.21 **(1r)** Notwithstanding sub. (1), if the governing body of a long–term care district, created under s. 46.2895 (1), adopts a resolution to elect to become a participating employer before May 15 of any year and official notice of that election is received by the department on or before May 15, the effective date of the participation of the long–term care district is the ensuing July 1.

AN ACT relating to: coverage of long-term care districts under the Wisconsin Retirement System.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

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(1) Participation of long-term care districts in the Wisconsin Retirement System. Notwithstanding section 40.21 (1) of the statutes, if the governing body of a long-term care district, created under section 46.2895 (1) of the statutes, as affected by 2007 Wisconsin Act 20, adopts a resolution to elect to become a participating employer under the Wisconsin Retirement System before May 15, 2008, and official notice of that election is received by the Department of Employee Trust Funds on or before May 15, 2008, the effective date of the participation of the long-term care district is July 1, 2008.

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
