Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB 462 will have no fiscal impact on the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission.

SB 462 will increase the workload of the Law Enforcement Standards Board but the Commission has insufficient information to evaluate whether the Board will be able to absorb this work using existing resources.

The evaluation and review thereof required by SB 462 will increase the costs of local and State law enforcement agencies.
