*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

5 SECTION 1. 118.51 (3) (a) 4. of the statutes is amended to read:

6 118.51 (3) (a) 4. On or before the first Friday following the first Monday in April  
7 following receipt of a copy of the application, if a resident school board denies a pupil's  
8 enrollment in a nonresident school district under sub. (6), (7) or (12) (b) 1., the  
9 resident school board shall notify the applicant and the nonresident school board, in  
10 writing, that the application has been denied and include in the notice the reason for  
11 the denial.

12 SECTION 2. 118.51 (4) (a) 5. of the statutes is repealed.

# Currently under the ~~current~~ full-time Open

Enrollment Program a pupil ~~generally~~ may attend a public school located outside the school district in which he or she resides

under certain conditions. Current law provides various bases for the pupil's school district

of residence to prohibit the transfer and for the school district that the pupil wishes to attend to reject the pupil's application for transfer.

One of these bases is a requirement that a school district eligible for special transfer aid commonly referred to as Chapter 220 aid reject an application for transfer into or out of the school district under the
