SUBJECT: Technical Memorandum on SB 506 – Insulating Concrete Forms and Energy

Efficient Products Credit

The bill does not define what is meant by costs to manufacture insulating concrete forms or energy efficient products. It is not clear if it would include the cost of the building where the items are manufactured, the equipment used to manufacture the items, or only wages, utilities, and raw materials. This should be clarified.

The proposed legislation makes no provision for the funding of the costs involved in administering the activities required. The administrative costs under this proposal are \$21,000 for printing of forms and \$8,400 for LTE salary and fringe. The LTEs are needed to perform the programming changes in WINPAS, develop business rules, and test the system. All costs are one time. If the author wishes to provide funding, appropriation language could be developed and costs allocated in the following manner:
