## **2007 SENATE BILL 515**

February 19, 2008 – Introduced by Senators Breske, Jauch, Lehman, Roessler, Lassa and Wirch, cosponsored by Representatives Boyle and Vos. Referred to Committee on Environment and Natural Resources.

- 1 AN ACT *to amend* 29.229 (4) (f); and *to create* 20.370 (6) (at), 29.5645 and 30.53
- 2 (3r) of the statutes; **relating to:** voluntary contributions for funding aquatic
- 3 invasive species grants and making an appropriation.

### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Natural Resources awards cost—sharing grants to public and private entities for up to 75 percent of the costs of projects to control invasive species. This bill authorizes an applicant for the issuance or renewal of a fishing license, of a certificate of number for a boat, or of a registration for a boat to make a voluntary contribution, in addition to the fee for the license, certificate, or registration, to be used to fund grants for projects for the control of aquatic invasive species.
