Purpose: The language below more accurately captures the likely process of the commission getting the record, reviewing it, and then asking for additional information. If we don't rework the language, then arguably the local government must provide the supplemental information within the original 30 day limit, or has no time limitation on providing the supplemental information.

At page 6, lines 12-15, 66.0401(5)(c)

Current: Upon receiving an appeal under par. (b), the commission shall notify the political subdivision. The political subdivision shall provide a certified copy of the record upon which it based its decision, and of any other relevant governmental records the commission may request, within 30 days after receiving notice.

Suggested: Upon receiving an appeal under par. (b), the commission shall notify the political subdivision. The political subdivision shall provide a certified copy of the record upon which it based its decision within 30 days after receiving notice. The commission may request of the political subdivision any other relevant governmental records, and the political subdivision shall provide such records within 30 days.
