notices concerning construction near or on lakes, streams, or wetlands that are given to applicants for building permits and other construction approvals, requiring the Department of Natural Resources to furnish informational brochures about wetlands laws, requiring the Department of Natural Resources to provide evaluations and statements about whether certain land contains wetlands, and making an appropriation.

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2007 SB 553 would require the Department of Commerce to include, on building permits the Department prescribes, certain language concerning compliance with requirements regarding construction near or on lakes, streams, or wetlands.

The Department currently prescribes and provides 1&2 family dwelling building permits (approximately 15,000 annually) and residential sanitary system permits (also approximately 15,000 annually) to local units of government. The costs associated with 2007 SB 553 would comprise revising the form and may involve disposal of an existing stock of the forms. The costs would be minimal and can be absorbed within current resources.
