I have some additional changes to request for the amendment to the Wetlands bill.

1. Page 1 Line 8 through end of the amendment - delete

2. Somewhere is section 2 add language along the lines of "Before implementation of the wetland identification section of this bill DNR will enter into a memorandum of agreement with United States Army corps of engineers to assure that Wetlands determinations offered to property owners by DNR will be recognized as valid by the US Army Corps of Engineers. Any determination done or approved by DNR will be valid for a period of five years"

3. Also somewhere in section 2 add "All wetlands identified through any of the tiered processes will be located and note on the current wetland inventory map. Delineations done by third parties and with DNR/Army Corps of Engineers

concurrence, shall be required to submit exact boundary location data."



This draft, among other things, requires DNR to negotiate with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to enter into a memorandum of agreement that provides that the Corps will concur with any written evaluation by DNR of whether a parcel of land contains a wetland under the wetland identification provision of the bill. This amendment does not specify for what purpose the Corps would be agreeing to the evaluation. Because of the urgency of providing this amendment draft to your office, I was not able to determine the possible purposes for which the Corps typically makes wetlands determinations. Without more information on this issue, it is difficult to know whether the language in the draft fully accomplishes your intent.

The amendment also provides that a wetland identification and a wetland confirmation remain in effect for 5 years. Again, this amendment does not specify for what purpose the identification or confirmation will remain in effect. For example, if DNR determines that a parcel contains a wetland, but 3 years later there is no longer evidence of a wetland on the parcel, the owner might be prohibited from putting a structure on that land for 2 more years. Is this consistent with your intent?

This draft, among other things, requires DNR to negotiate with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to enter into a memorandum of agreement that provides that the Corps will concur with any written evaluation by DNR of whether a parcel of land contains a wetland under the wetland identification provision of the bill. This amendment does not specify for what purpose the Corps would be agreeing to the evaluation. Because of the urgency of providing this amendment draft to your office, I was not able to determine the possible purposes for which the Corps typically makes wetlands determinations. Without more information on this issue, it is difficult to know whether the language in the draft fully accomplishes your intent.

The amendment also provides that a wetland identification and a wetland confirmation remain in effect for five years. Again, this amendment does not specify for what purpose the identification or confirmation will remain in effect. For example, if DNR determines that a parcel contains a wetland, but three years later there is no longer evidence of a wetland on the parcel, the owner might be prohibited from putting a structure on that land for two more years. Is this consistent with your intent?
