(1m) (b) The department of public instruction shall > promulgate administrative rules to establish a fixed percentage rate > of reimbursement for the salaries of licensed school nurses, licensed > school social workers, licensed school psychologists, and licensed school > counselors. Peter,

We don't think we need to amend s. 115.882. Prior to 1999 we had language that prorated psych and social work based on a recognition that while a special education teacher is 100 percent allocated to students with disabilities, these pupil services positions are not. Even back when we had sum sufficient funding, we reimbursed psych and social work at a lower level. After the appropriation became sum certain (around 1985 I think) and until 1999, teachers' reimbursement rate was higher than that for psychologists and social workers.

No, we don't want the same percentage for all four pupil service positions. The percentage will vary by the average amount of time a particular position serves children with disabilities.

Does this clarify things?

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION #.

[rev: 9/18/06 DF02(fm)]

Section #. 115.88 (1m) of the statutes is amended to read:

115.88 (1m) PROGRAM AID. (a) If, upon receipt of the plan under s. 115.77 (4), the state superintendent is satisfied that the special education program has been maintained during the preceding school year in accordance with law, the state superintendent shall certify to the department of administration in favor of each county, cooperative educational service agency, and school district maintaining such special education program a sum equal to the amount expended by the county, agency, and school district during the preceding year for salaries of personnel enumerated in sub. (1), the salary portion of any authorized contract for physical or occupational therapy services; the salary portion of any contract to provide special education services to pupils attending a charter school, as authorized under sub. (1); and other expenses approved by the state superintendent, as costs eligible for reimbursement from the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (b).

(am) If the operator of a charter school established under s. 118.40 (2r) operates a special education program and the state superintendent is satisfied that the operator of the charter school is complying with 20 USC 1400 to 14910, the state superintendent shall certify to the department of administration in favor of the operator of the charter school a sum equal to the amount that the operator of the charter school expended during the previous school year for salaries of full–time or part–time licensed teachers, licensed coordinators of special education, licensed school nurses, licensed school social workers, licensed school psychologists, licensed school counselors, paraprofessionals, licensed consulting teachers to work with any teacher of regular education programs who has a child with a disability in a class and any other personnel, as determined by the state superintendent. Certified costs under this paragraph are eligible for reimbursement from the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (b). The state superintendent may audit costs under this paragraph and adjust reimbursement to cover only actual, eligible costs.
