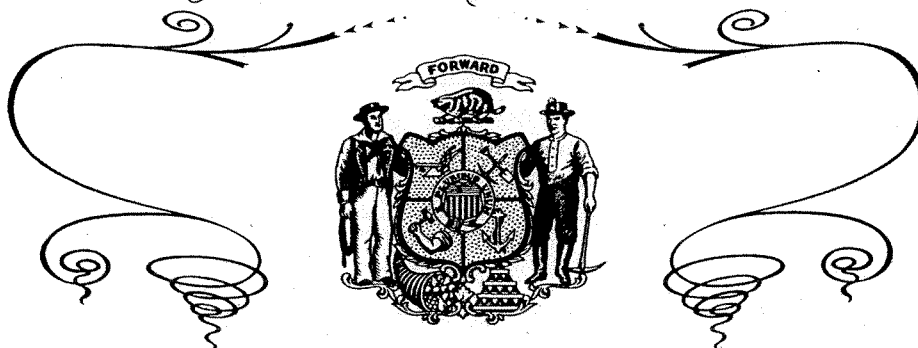

Whereas, Captain Schiller completed the Infantry Officer Basic Course, the Basic Airborne Course, and Ranger School at Fort Benning, Georgia, and was assigned to the 82nd Airborne Division, was a platoon leader in Company B, 3rd Battalion, 505th Parachute Infantry Regiment, and later the Executive Officer for Company A; and

Whereas, Captain Schiller was given the Bronze Star Medal, Purple Heart, Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Iraqi Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Army Service Ribbon, the Ranger Tab, the Combat Infantryman Badge, the Expert Infantryman Badge, the Master Parachutist Badge, and graduated from the Reconnaissance and Surveillance Leader's Course at Fort Benning, Georgia, as the honor graduate; and

Whereas, Captain Schiller was known for caring for his fellow soldiers, raising spirits, and touching the lives of everyone he met; and
