Whereas, the city of Chicago, Illinois, has proposed hosting the summer Olympic Games in 2016, and in July 2006 the United States Olympic Committee selected Chicago as one of two United States Candidate City finalists for the 2016 Games; and

Whereas, the goal of the Olympic Movement is to contribute to building a peaceful and better world by educating youth through sport practiced without discrimination of any kind and in the Olympic spirit, which requires mutual understanding with a spirit of friendship, solidarity, and fair play; and

Whereas, the Chicago 2016 Olympic Games and Paralympic Games will use sport as a catalyst to strengthen the Olympic Movement and showcase the city's world class, accessible infrastructure, and enthusiastic multicultural community; and

Whereas, the Wisconsin legislature believes that the prospect of the city of Chicago hosting the 2016 Olympic Games presents an incredible opportunity to promote regional cooperation between Illinois, Wisconsin, and surrounding states; and
