


Relating to: declaring March 2007 American Red Cross Month.

Whereas, each year during the month of March we recognize the humanitarian service and the lifesaving programs of the American Red Cross. Part of the international Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement, the American Red Cross was formed 125 years ago and chartered by the US Congress to provide aid and comfort in times of crisis. Since the early years of twentieth century, the Red Cross in Wisconsin has played a critical role in helping our citizens prevent, prepare for and respond to emergencies; and

Whereas, American Red Cross volunteers and staff responded to 878 local disasters throughout the state of Wisconsin last year, providing emergency assistance to 1300 families affected by fire, flood, tornadoes and other disasters. In 2006, 85,932 persons learned to prevent and prepare for disasters by participating in Red Cross community disaster education programs; and

Whereas, 240,000 Wisconsin individuals are prepared to help their neighbors in a crisis because they have been trained in Red Cross life saving classes. These classes include CPR, use of automated external defibrillators (AEDs), first aid, aquatics, babysitting and HIV/AIDS education; and

Whereas, Wisconsin Red Cross chapters served 361,9444 people in 2006 through a variety of community programs, including transportation services and initiatives for low income, elderly, and special needs populations; and

Whereas, Armed Forces Emergency Services caseworkers transmitted 4,263 emergency messages between members of the Armed Forces and their families and loved ones; and

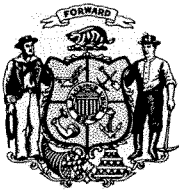
