



2007 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 31

1 **Relating to:** the life and military service of United States Air Force Senior Airman
2 Adam Servais.

3 Whereas, Senior Airman Adam Servais was born on September 1, 1982, in La
4 Crosse, Wisconsin, to Pete and Susan Servais, and died on August 19, 2006, of
5 injuries sustained in combat from enemy action in Afghanistan; and

6 Whereas, Senior Airman Adam Servais was a 2001 graduate of Onalaska High
7 School and enlisted in the United States Air Force in 2002; and

8 Whereas, Senior Airman Adam Servais served with distinction in the elite 23rd
9 Special Tactics Squadron, where he served as a combat controller, and earned his
10 combat controller red beret in June of 2003, and was in his second tour of duty in the
11 Middle East; and

12 Whereas, Senior Airman Adam Servais's family and fellow citizens are very
13 proud of him and know that he died honorably serving the nation; and

1 Whereas, Senior Airman Adam Servais embodied the Air Force’s core values of
2 “integrity first, service before self, and excellence in all we do” and he is sorely
3 missed; now, therefore, be it

4 ***Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That*** the legislature of
5 the state of Wisconsin commemorates the remarkable life of United States Air Force
6 Senior Airman Adam Servais and extends its deepest sympathies to his family,
7 friends, and colleagues; and, be it further

8 ***Resolved, That*** the senate chief clerk shall transmit a copy of this joint
9 resolution to his parents, Pete and Susan Servais.
