

## 2007 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 34

April 13, 2007 – Introduced by Senators RISSER, LAZICH, BRESKE, ROESSLER, ERPENBACH and MILLER, cosponsored by Representatives BLACK, JESKEWITZ, KERKMAN, BERCEAU, TURNER and NYGREN. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1     **Relating to:** congratulating the 2006–07 University of Wisconsin women’s hockey  
2           team.

3           Whereas, the 2006–07 University of Wisconsin (UW) women’s hockey team won  
4     its second consecutive NCAA Division I Women’s Ice Hockey National Championship  
5     with a 4–1 win over the University of Minnesota–Duluth on March 18, 2007; and

6           Whereas, the UW women’s hockey team finished its back–to–back  
7     championship season with a remarkable 36–1–4 record, finishing with a  
8     record–setting 26–game unbeaten streak; and

9           Whereas, the Badgers’ championship win broke or tied six NCAA single–season  
10    team records: most wins (36), best winning percentage (.927), fewest losses (1), most  
11    home wins (19), fewest goals allowed per game (0.88), and lowest goals against  
12    average (0.85); and

13           Whereas, the Badger women’s hockey team is the first UW program to repeat  
14    as NCAA champions since women’s cross country won the title in 1984 and 1985; and
