Whereas, head coach Bo Ryan received the Adolph Rupp Cup as the national coach of the year and Senior Alando Tucker was selected as a first-team All-American, the first ever UW player named as a first-team All American by the Associated Press; and

Whereas, the Badger women's team, whose roster contains no seniors, closed out its season with a program-best 23 wins, with 17 coming at home, the most in school history; and

Whereas, head coach Lisa Stone from Oregon, Wisconsin, ranks 22nd in overall winning percentage among active Division I coaches with a record 408-169 (.707) and has consistently boasted Academic All-Big Ten honorees in her coaching career at UW; and

Whereas, Junior Jolene Anderson from Port Wing, Wisconsin was named first team All-Big Ten and is the fastest UW player to collect 1,000 and 1,500 career points; now, therefore, be it
