1st Battalion, 8th Infantry Regiment, 3rd Heavy Brigade Combat Team of Fort				
Carson, Colorado, proudly and faithfully served the people of Wisconsin and the				
United States with distinction and honor in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom; and				
Whereas, Specialist Grant A. Dampier was a wrestler for, and year 2000				
graduate of, Merrill High School, worked for Marathon Electric in Wausau, and				
enjoyed the Green Bay Packers, off-road truck racing, and fishing; and				
Whereas, Specialist Grant A. Dampier loved his family, wife Heidi and 3
