

2007 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 55

August 2, 2007 – Introduced by Senator KEDZIE, cosponsored by Representative
LOTHIAN. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1 **Relating to:** recognizing Kikkoman and its contribution to the cultural and
2 economic vitality of Wisconsin.

3 Whereas, the people of the state of Wisconsin have a sincere respect and
4 appreciation for Kikkoman’s 50 years of marketing and operations in the state; and
