Whereas, Corporal Hugo loved her Country and family and was honored to serve both and will be deeply missed by friends and family and those she served with; now, therefore be it

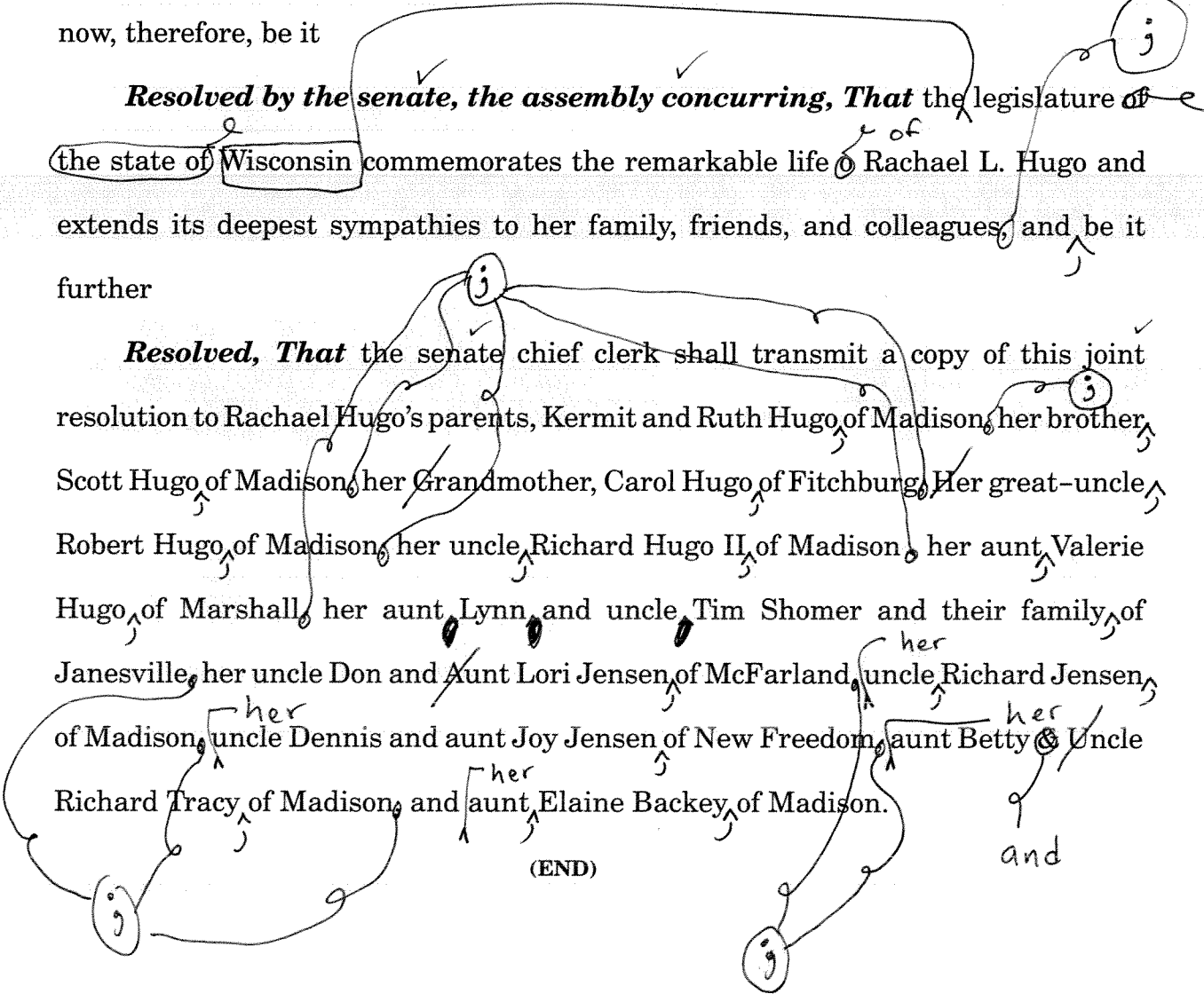
