WHEREAS, the Warhawk victory ended Mount Union's 37-game winning streak and deprived the Purple Raiders of their tenth national title in the last 15 years; and

WHEREAS, this was UW-Whitewater's third consecutive appearance in the Amos Alonzo Stagg Bowl, proving that the third time is the charm; and

WHEREAS, UW-Whitewater was 14-1 on the season, with its only loss coming to a NCAA Division II school; and
