*Whereas*, Lance Corporal Andrew Matus was a 2005 graduate of Weyerhaeuser High School in Weyerhaeuser, Wisconsin and enlisted in the United States Marine Corps in 2005; and

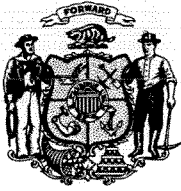
