Relating to: the distinguished career of Bruce Munson in his service to the

3	Whereas, Bruce Munson began his career in October 1977 as an assistant
4	revisor of statutes in the Revisor of Statutes Bureau; and
5	Whereas, Mr. Munson succeeded Orlan Prestegard as revisor of statutes in
6	January 1990; and
7	Whereas, Bruce Munson retired as the revisor of statutes on December 31,
8	2007; and
9	Whereas, as revisor of statutes, Mr. Munson, with the assistance of his staff,
10	implemented many innovations including the posting of the Wisconsin Statutes on
11	an electronic bulletin board, the precursor to the Internet version; and
12	Whereas, due to the limited space on the electronic bulletin board, the statutes
13	were published on a new medium, the CD-ROM, beginning with the 1989 statutes;

1	Whereas, the revisor's bureau implemented cost–saving measures in
2	publishing the Wisconsin Statutes; and
3	Whereas, commencing in 1993, the revisor's bureau revised the publishing and
4	printing of the Wisconsin Administrative Code to provide for easier use and printing;
5	and
6	Whereas, the revisor's bureau has worked closely with the Legislative
7	Technology Services Bureau to format the administrative code for incorporation into
8	a searchable database; and
9	Whereas, after commencing the searchable database for the code, the statutes,
10	acts, and supreme court rules were also added to the database; and
11	Whereas, throughout his career, Bruce Munson conducted himself with
12	integrity, dignity, and professionalism, and served the legislature and state
13	government with honor and distinction; now, therefore, be it
14	Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That the members of the
15	Wisconsin legislature commend Bruce Munson on his career, dedication,
16	accomplishments, and service to the citizens of Wisconsin; and be it further
17	Resolved, That the senate chief clerk shall provide a copy of this joint
18	resolution to Bruce Munson.
