

Although I am not certain on the format, Senator Kanavas would like the following "whereas" clauses contained in the joint resolution:

- Born June 20, 1926 in Milwaukee and died January 2, 2008 at his home in Waukesha.
- Graduated from Washington High School in Milwaukee.
- Served in U.S. Navy during World War II.
- Attended the University of Wisconsin - Madison, earning a bachelor's degree in 1949, a master's degree in 1952 and a doctorate in communication in 1957.
- Served as the ninth president of Wisconsin State University - Stevens Point and was named the first chancellor of UW-Stevens Point following the UW system merger, becoming known as "the Students' Chancellor".
- Speaking with a direct style and uncommon personal nature was rewarded with broad bipartisan support of people across Wisconsin.

- Wearing his signature red vest, became Wisconsin's 40th governor in 1979, choosing to serve in the state's highest office for only one term.
- Continued to serve his the state long after he left the governor's office as a member of the UW System Board of Regents and as interim Superintendent of Public Instruction.
- Is survived by his wife Joyce, his son, The Honorable Lee Dreyfus, Jr., his daughter Susan Fosdick, six grandchildren and four great grandchildren.

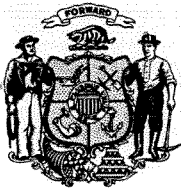
