Tracy grew up in New Auburn Wisconsin, and was an avid barrel-racer. Tracy was a 1995 graduate of Chetek Wisconsin High School and went on to graduate from the University of Wisconsin – River Falls with a degree in graphic design.

Tracy worked as a graphic design artist and a certified nursing assistant at a nursing home until she enlisted in the United States Army in January 2006.

Tracy served with distinction in the 3rd Battalion, 197th Infantry Regiment, 3rd Brigade Combat team, 101st Airborne Division in Fort Campbell, Kentucky, and was on her first tour of duty in Iraq.

Tracy's family and friends are very proud of her service and know she died in honor and courage, doing what she wanted to do by serving her country.

Tracy embodied the Army's core values of loyalty, duty, respect, selfless service, honor, integrity, and personal service and will be sorely missed.
