May 1/2006 - Introduced by Senators Lassa Roessler and Coggs. Referred to Committee on Health, Children, Families, Aging and Long Term Care.

1 **Relating to:** encouraging public and private employers to establish and promote 2 healthful lifestyle programs and encouraging economic incentives to stimulate the widespread adoption of such programs. 3 Whereas, unwise lifestyle choices are a significant cause of cancer, diabetes, 5 chronic lung disease, hypertension, heart disease, stroke, and accidental death and injury and contribute to the morbidity and disability of numerous other chronic resulting from diseases; and Whereas, the combined national cost for the morbidity, mortality, and disability 9 of preventable obesity, smoking, substance abuse, and seat belt neglect exceeds \$400,000,000 annually (25 percent of all health spending); and 10 11 Whereas, obesity alone has become epidemic in America and in Wisconsin. having doubled in the past 20 years and now affecting 21 percent of the adult 12 population; and 13 14 Whereas, the cultural shift necessary to reverse these trends and inspire

healthful lifestyles will require the broad participation of social leaders.
