

2007 SENATE ~~JOINT~~ RESOLUTION

1 **Relating to:** reauthorization of the federal State Health Insurance Assistance
2 Program.

3 Whereas, the Wisconsin ^{or senate} legislature regards the health of our children to be of
4 paramount importance to families in our state; and

5 Whereas, the Wisconsin ^{or senate} legislature regards poor child health as a threat to the
6 educational achievement and social and psychological well-being of the children of
7 our state; and

8 Whereas, the Wisconsin ^{or senate} legislature considers protecting the health of our
9 children to be essential to the well-being of our youngest citizens and the quality of
10 life in our state; and

11 Whereas, the Wisconsin ^{or senate} legislature considers the State Health Insurance
12 Assistance Program (SHIP), which enrolls 96,114 children and their parents through
13 the successful BadgerCare program, to be an integral part of the arrangements for
14 health benefits for the children of our state; and

1 Whereas, the Wisconsin ^{Senate} legislature recognizes the value of SHIP in preserving
2 child wellness, preventing and treating childhood disease, improving health
3 outcomes, and reducing overall health costs; and

4 Whereas, the Wisconsin ^{Senate} legislature considers the federal funding available for
5 SHIP to be indispensable to providing health benefits for children of modest means;
6 now, therefore, be it

7 **Resolved by the Senate, the assembly concurring, That** the members of the
8 Wisconsin legislature urge the members of Wisconsin's delegation to the United
9 States Congress to ensure that the Congress timely reauthorizes the State Children
10 Health Insurance Program (SCHIP) to assure federal funding for SHIP; and, be it
11 further

12 **Resolved, That** the members of the Wisconsin ^{Senate} legislature urge the governor
13 to use his best efforts to work with the Wisconsin delegation to ensure that SCHIP
14 is reauthorized in a timely manner; and, be it further

15 **Resolved, That** the members of the Wisconsin ^{Senate} legislature proclaim that all
16 components of state government should work together with educators, health care
17 providers, social workers, and parents to ensure that all available public and private
18 assistance for providing health benefits to uninsured children in this state be used
19 to the maximum extent possible; and, be it further

20 **Resolved, That** the members of the Wisconsin ^{Senate} legislature urge the governor
21 to use his best efforts to provide meaningful assistance to help identify and enroll
22 children who qualify for Medical Assistance or SHIP.
