November 7, 2007 - Introduced by Senators Taylor, Lazich, Sullivan and Darling, cosponsored by Representatives Toles, Zepnick Gricsby, Wasserman, KRUSICK, GUNDRUM, JESKEWITZ, SINICKI, TURNER and YOUNG. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

Relating to: the life of David F. Schulz who passed away on Sunday, the 7th of 2 October, 2007, after many years of government and academic service. Whereas, David "Dave" Schulz was born on September 24, 1949, in Milwaukee, 3 the oldest of five children of Robert L. and Mary M. Schulz; and 4 5 Whereas, David Schulz received a bachelor's degree in civil engineering from Purdue University and a master's degree in public management from Northwestern 6 7 University; and 8 Whereas, from 1983 to 1984, he served as the first budget director for Chicago's 9 mayor, Harold Washington, and worked to resolve the city's record billion-dollar 10 deficit; and Whereas, upon returning to Milwaukee in 1984, he served as the budget 11 12 director to the administration of County Executive Bill O'Donnell, and as Parks Director from 1985 to 1987; and 13 14 Whereas, David Schulz was elected Milwaukee County's third County 15 Executive in 1988, and served in that post until 1991; and

1	whereas, David Schulz was the first person to ascend to the position of County					
2	Executive without previously serving as County Board chairman and the first to beat					
3	an incumbent in the history of the position; and					
4	Whereas, the accomplishments of his administration include completing the					
5	building of a county jail, upgrading the Mitchell International Airport, building					
6	O'Donnell Park on the lakefront, and overhauling social services; and					
7	Whereas, since 1992, David Schulz served as the executive director of the					
8	Infrastructure Technology Institute at Northwestern University, which he founded;

10	Whereas, at the time of his death, David Schulz was an adjunct professor at					
11	Northwestern's Institute of Civil and Environmental Engineering; and					
12	Whereas, the people of the state of Wisconsin mourn the death of David Schulz,					
13	and celebrate the accomplishments of his extraordinary life; and					
14	Whereas, David Schulz is survived by his wife, Jo Ann, and son, Bobby, of					
15	Winthrop Harbor, Illinois, and his three brothers, Jerry, William, and Peter; now,
