Whereas, Hugo Harrison Henry, husband of Mary Henry, father of Kevin, Duane, Kimberly, Marc, Marcena, Eric, and Tiffany; passed away at the age of 60 on Monday, March 17, 2008; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Henry was a respected and beloved member of the Beloit community in his capacities as teacher, city council member, mentor, role model, speaker and singer; and;

WHEREAS, Mr. Henry taught social studies and history for 34 years at Beloit Memorial High School and then McNeel Middle School, and was named Teacher of the Year at each school; and

WHEREAS, he dedicated all of his life to teaching, tutoring, mentoring, and encouraging children to reach their full potential through such avenues as the Merrill Community Center, the Black Male Role Model Group, the Beloit College pre-collegiate programs;
