On behalf of the HEAB, I request draft language for the following proposed statutory changes. There are two attachments with this email. Thank you in advance for your assistance, and please call me at 264-6181 if you need further information.

2. 39.435(3) Wisconsin Higher Education Grants – Incrementally Increase Maximum

Problem: A statutorily determined dollar amount indicates the maximum WHEG a student can receive in a given school year. In 06-07 the WHEG appropriation allowed for a higher maximum than was statutorily allowed. Although we requested that the WHEG maximum be increased in the 0507 biennial

budget it was unchanged. We were able to change this in the interim session from \$2,500 to \$3,000.

39.435(3) Grants under sub. (1) shall not be less than \$250 during any one academic year, unless the Joint Committee on Finance approves an adjustment in the amount of the minimum grant. Grants under sub. (1) shall not exceed \$3,000 during any one academic year. The board shall, by rule, establish a reporting system to periodically provide student economic data and shall promulgate other rules the board deems necessary to assure uniform administration of the program.

Solution: Tie the WHEG maximum to 50% of UW – Madison's prior year tuition. This would allow the statutory maximum to increase gradually without legislative action.
