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


## Repeal Group Home Revolving Loan Fund

### Current Language

s. 20.435 (6) (gd) and s. 46.976 (2)

### Proposed Change

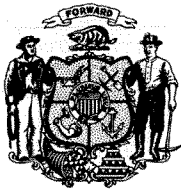
Repeal s. 20.435 (6) (gd) [numeric 629] and s. 46.976 (2).

### Background and Rational for the Change

Under 45 CFR 96.129 (of 1993), the State, as a condition of receiving federal Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant funds, was required to establish and provide for the on-going operation of a revolving fund to make loans for the costs of establishing programs for the provision of housing in which individuals recovering from alcohol and drug abuse may reside in groups of not less than six individuals. The State was also required to provide not less than \$100,000 for the revolving fund. Loans made from the revolving fund could not exceed \$4,000 and each loan must have been repaid within 2 years. The federal Children's Health Services Act of 2000 makes this provision optional.

Act 25, the 05-07 biennial budget, eliminated this program and transferred the unencumbered balance in the appropriation account under section 20.435 (6) (gd), 2003 stats., to the appropriation account under section 20.435 (7) (md) of the statutes. As a technical follow-up step to this action in the 05-07 budget bill, s. 20.435 (6) (gd) and s. 46.976 (2) need to be repealed in the 2007-09 budget.

Currently, DHFS administers a fund, known as the "group home revolving loan fund," to make limited two-year loans to applying nonprofit organizations to establish housing programs for individuals who are recovering from alcohol or other drug abuse. This bill eliminates the group home revolving loan fund.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

2 SECTION 1. 20.435 (6) (gd) of the statutes is repealed.

\*\*\*NOTE: This SECTION involves a change in an appropriation that must be reflected in the revised schedule in s. 20.005, stats.

3 SECTION 2. 46.976 of the statutes is repealed.

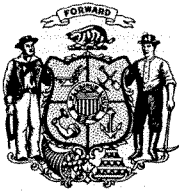
LRB 07-0247/1 has been reviewed by the Division and OSF. The draft requires no changes.
