3. Bond Increase for Soil & Water Resource Management (SWRM) Cost Share, DI# 5720

Explanation:

In 2002, new administrative rules (ATCP 50 and NR 151) were adopted to protect soil and water quality from farm runoff. These rules provide a framework to control soil erosion, reduce polluted runoff from farm buildings and fields, design safer manure storage facilities, and apply nutrients more precisely. DNR adopted farm performance standards to prevent farm runoff as part of NR 151, and DATCP prescribed the conservation practices that farmers must implement to meet the standards. Farmers receive cost-sharing grants if they are required to install conservation practices that change "existing" farm operations. The cost-share offer must cover at least 70 percent of the farmer's cost to install and maintain the required practice and may cover 90 percent if a farmer demonstrates economic hardship.

At the time that ATCP 50 was promulgated, DATCP determined that approximately \$10 million was needed annually, over and above the existing local, state, and federal funds estimated to be available to farmers currently and that are necessary to reach the state's new soil and water quality goals. The legislature authorized the use of bond revenue to pay for certain cost share practices. The amount authorized to date will be expended or committed by the end of the 2005-07 biennium. To meet the needs, DATCP requests an increase in GPR bonding authority from \$26,075,000 to \$31,575,000.

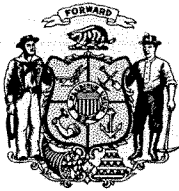

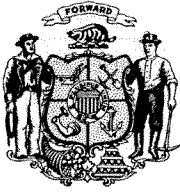
