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

Combine 2 alpha appropriation into one so it would combine 20.435(2)(b) and 20.435(2)(bm) into (2)(bm) for the Wisconsin Resource Center and Sand Ridge.

High Priority



Combine Numerics 202 and 203 into the Same Alpha Appropriation

Current Language

- s. 20.435(2)(b) [note: this is numeric appropriation 202]
s. 20.435(2)(bm) [note: this is numeric appropriation 203]

Proposed Change

s. 20.435(2)(b)

~~(b) *Wisconsin Resource Center*. The amounts in the schedule for general program operations, other than operations related to security, of the Wisconsin Resource Center.~~

s. 20.435(2)(bm) [note: this would include numeric appropriations 202 and 203]

(bm) *Secure mental health units or facilities*. The amounts in the schedule for the general program operations of secure mental health units or facilities under s. 980.065 for persons committed under s. 980.06 and placed in a secure mental health unit or facility, and for general program operations, other than operations related to security, of the Wisconsin Resource Center under s. 46.056.

Effect of the Change

Combines numeric appropriations 202 (Wisconsin Resource Center) and 203 (Secure Mental Health Units or Facilities) into a single alpha appropriation under s. 20.435(2)(bm). The two GPR numerics are currently assigned to separate alpha appropriations (s.20.435(2)(b) and s.20.435(2)(bm), respectively).

Rationale for the Change

The Department of Health and Family Services (DHFS) functions that are funded through these numeric appropriations are very similar in that they both fund operations for secure mental health units or secure facilities. Numeric 203, under appropriation s. 20.435(2)(bm), Secure Mental Health Units or Facilities, funds institutional services for sexually violent persons (SVPs) at both

the Wisconsin Resource Center and the Sand Ridge Secure Treatment Center. Numeric 202, under appropriation s. 20.435(2)(b), Wisconsin Resource Center, funds costs at the Wisconsin Resource Center as those services relate to mental health services for correctional inmates.

The Wisconsin Resource Center serves both SVPs and mentally ill inmates. Staff and funding need to be managed across the two populations to respond to changes in the client census of each population. Combining the two numerics into the same alpha under s. 20.435(2)(bm), Secure Mental Health Units or Facilities, would allow DHFS to manage the GPR funds between these facility operations in a more timely fashion as changes in the SVP and mentally ill inmate populations occur. The functions will continue to be managed through separate numeric appropriations.

This bill combines the general purpose revenue appropriation for general program operations of the Wisconsin Resource Center (a facility that is used to provide mental health services to prison inmates, and at which persons committed to DHFS as sexually violent persons may be placed) with the general purpose revenue appropriation for program operations of other secure mental health facilities or units at which persons committed to DHFS as sexually violent persons are placed.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 20.435 (2) (b) of the statutes is repealed.

***NOTE: This SECTION involves a change in an appropriation that must be reflected in the revised schedule in s. 20.005, stats.

1 **SECTION 2.** 20.435 (2) (bm) of the statutes is amended to read:
2 20.435 (2) (bm) *Secure mental health units or facilities.* The amounts in the
3 schedule for the general program operations of the Wisconsin Resource Center under
4 s. 46.056 and other secure mental health units or facilities under s. 980.065 for at
