Issue/Topic:	Removal of Vehicle Impact Fee Sunset Date
Proposed Change:	342.14 (1r) Upon filing an application under sub. (1) or (3), an environmental impact fee of \$9, by the person filing the application. All moneys collected under this subsection shall be credited to the environmental fund for environmental management. This subsection does not apply after December 31, 2007.
Explanatory Note:	Amend Wis. Stat. s.342.14 to eliminate the 12/31/2007 sunset for the \$9 environmental impact fee referenced in that section. The fee, established in 1997 Wisconsin Act 27, is imposed on the filing of new and used vehicle title applications. Revenue from this fee is deposited into the Environmental Fund.
