Grant to the Center for Veteran Issues (DIN 6020, page 266)

The Center was formed in the mid-1980s as an advisory group to agencies serving minority veterans. It began providing direct services in 1988 when it purchased two duplexes on Milwaukee's north side—VETS Place North and VETS Place Park Hill—and collaborated with the Social Development Commission (SDC), to use these facilities as housing and a place to provide supportive services to homeless veterans. The Center was incorporated as a not-for-profit organization in March 1989. In June 1994, CVI purchased and began renovating a former community hospital to provide housing to veterans in Milwaukee. This facility, now known as VETS Place Central, houses 72 homeless veterans in a transitional living program and 12 senior veterans in single-room occupancy units.

Proposed non-statutory language:

Grant to Center for Veterans Issues. From the appropriation under section 20.485 (2) (ab) of the statutes, as created by this act, a grant of \$25,000 in each year of the 2007-09 fiscal biennium, to the Center for Veterans Issues, Inc., for outreach activities for homeless veterans.

Statutory appropriation language:

20.485 (2) (ab) of the statutes is created to read:

20.485 (2) (ab) *Grant to Center for Veterans Issues.* From the general fund, annually, in the amounts in the schedule, for two grants to the Center for Veterans Issues, Inc., under 2007 Wisconsin Act ... (this act), section ...
